Jeralyn E. Merritt assumes position as treasurer of nation's top criminal defense organization

Washington D.C.—Jeralyn E. Merritt, a criminal defense attorney in Denver, CO, was sworn in as treasurer of the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers at the organization's annual meeting last week in Denver.

A life member of the NACDL, Merritt has a long tradition of active service to the organization, including six years on the board of directors as well as co-chair of the NACDL Legislative, Innocence Project and Internet Committees. She served as secretary of the organization last year. Merritt was the regular author of the "Legislation" column in *The Champion* magazine for five years and received the first annual *Marshall Stern Award* for Outstanding Legislative Achievement in 1995.

Merritt is a lecturer in law at Denver University's College of Law teaching "Wrongful Convictions" and "Criminal Defense," and is a frequent lecturer at NACDL and other legal education seminars. She has active leadership roles in the American Board of Criminal Lawyers, the Martindale Hubbell-Lexis-Nexis Legal Advisory Board and the ABA Criminal Justice Section.

A legal analyst since 1996, Merritt frequently appears on the Fox News Channel, CNN, and MSNBC. She is also the creator of www.crimelynx.com and www.talkleft.com, Internet resources for criminal defense lawyers and journalists covering crime-based news and politics.
