
SEXUAL ASSAULT DEFENSE RESOURCES

1. MANUAL: SEXUAL ASSAULT: CHALLENGING PROPENSITY, PRIOR ACTS, AND SANE EXAMINATION EVIDENCE

Description: NACDL's Sexual Assault Resource Manual will help you devise an effective strategy for challenging propensity evidence using a two-pronged line of attack, identifying and understanding junk science in sex assault cases with a focus on rape trauma syndrome & child abuse accommodation, dealing with non-physical evidence such as dolls, art therapy, and interviews, and what to do with physical evidence. This manual will include a basic evidence checklist on a rape kit examination, and a DNA checklist for sexual assault. An entire chapter addresses SANE Examinations, including evidence collection forms, kits, medical examiner and SANE nurse protocols, language for use in cross-examination, sample examination areas for the medical personnel treating a patient, and much more.
