

## Criminal records can prevent you from obtaining housing, employment, and educational opportunities. Come to the clinic to get eligible charges off your record to ease these obstacles.

Not all criminal charges are eligible for expungement; you can learn more about which charges are eligible for expungement at the link.

Please note that your criminal record must include Charlottesville and/or Albemarle charges to expunge at this clinic.

**If you do not pre-register**, please bring the Warrant of Arrest, Summons, or Final Letter of Disposition for each charge you seek expungement for. Volunteer pro bono attorneys and UVA law students will be present to provide assistance
