UNOPPOSED MOTION TO SUPPLEMENT RECORD

Lamar Redfern, through counsel, respectfully requests this Court to allow him to supplement the record in connection with his outstanding motion for compassionate release, Dkt. No. 204, and his memorandum in support of that motion, Dkt. No. 243. Specifically, Redfern requests that the record be supplemented with documents from the Bureau of Prisons that provide additional information and context to his most recent disciplinary infraction, which occurred on August 23, 2018.¹

Per his request, Counsel for Redfern filed a request for documents related to the infraction with the Bureau of Prisons on August 13, 2021 under the Freedom of Information Act. The documents were received on November 19, 2021, five weeks after Redfern filed a memorandum in support of his motion for compassionate release. All documents related to the infraction, as received from and redacted by the Bureau of Prisons, are attached as Proposed Exhibit 1. Because Redfern did not have access to these documents at the time of his most recent filing, and because it would serve the interests of justice to provide the Court with a more complete view of his most recent disciplinary infraction, Redfern asks the Court to grant this motion.

¹ Redfern's most recent disciplinary infraction prior to this was on December 29, 2017. Dkt. No. 243-13.

YOUR DUE PROCESS RIGHTS WERE REVIEWED WITH YOU BY THE DHO AT THE TIME OF THE HEARING. YOU STATED YOU UNDERSTOOD YOUR RIGHTS AND HAD NO DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE TO PRESENT. YOU DID NOT REQUEST ANY WITNESSES AND YOU DECLINED THE SERVICES OF A STAFF REPRESENTATIVE TO ASSIST YOU AT THE HEARING. YOU INDICATED TO THE DHO YOU WERE READY TO PROCEED WITH THE HEARING.

THE DHO BASES THIS DECISION ON THE FACTS PRESENTED IN THE BODY OF THE WRITTEN REPORT. AT APPROXIMATELY 1:00 P.M., ON AUGUST 23, 2018, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) CONDUCTED A SEARCH OF INMATE REDFERN, LAMAR REG. #17500-058, AND DISCOVERED (1) ONE SMALL PIECE OF UNKNOWN PAPER, CUT INTO A RECTANGLE, WITH LINES DRAWN ON ONE SIDE. THE PAPER HAD A YELLOWISH COLOR. SPECIFICALLY, INSIDE THE RIGHT FRONT POCKET OF INMATE REDFERN'S INSIDE SET OF PANTS. DUE TO THE APPEARANCE OF THE SUBSTANCE, THE OFFICER TESTED THE SUBSTANCE WITH THE NIK TEST KITS "A" AND "U." THE NIK TEST KIT "A" PRODUCED A POSITIVE RESULT FOR AMPHETAMINES. THE OFFICER THEN TRANSITIONED TO THE NIK TEST KIT "U" WHICH PRODUCED A POSITIVE RESULT FOR AMPHETAMINE. ALL OF THE SUBSTANCE WAS USED IN TESTING.

YOU DENIED THE CHARGE BEFORE THE DHO AND STATED, "THEY WERE NOT MINE. THEY WERE (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) PANTS. I DID NOT KNOW ANYTHING WAS IN THE POCKETS."

YOU REQUESTED (b)(6); (b)(7)(C); (b)(7)(F) AS A WITNESS. HE APPEARED DURING THE HEARING AND STATED, "I SOLD HIM A PAIR OF SHORTS AND FORGOT THAT I LEFT IT IN THE POCKETS."

(b)(6); (b)(7)(C) WAS CLEAR IN THE BODY OF HIS WRITTEN REPORT THAT HE DISCOVERED ONE SMALL PIECE OF AN UNKNOWN PAPER SUBSTANCE INSIDE THE RIGHT FRONT POCKET OF THE INSIDE SET OF YOUR PANTS. HE TESTED THE PAPER WITH THE NIK TEST KITS "A" AND "U", WHICH PRODUCED A POSITIVE RESULT FOR AMPHETAMINES. YOU DENIED THE CHARGE AND STATED THEY WEREN'T YOUR PANTS AND YOU DIDN'T KNOW ANYTHING WAS IN THE POCKETS. YOUR WITNESS, (b)(6); (b)(7)(C) APPEARED DURING THE HEARING AND COLLABORATED YOUR STORY. THE DHO CONSIDERED THIS STATEMENT; HOWEVER, REGARDLESS OF THE ORIGINAL OWNER OF THE DRUGS, YOU WERE FOUND IN POSSESSION AS THEY WERE IN A POCKET OF THE PANTS YOU WERE WEARING. WHEN YOU PURCHASED THESE PANTS FROM AN INMATE AND FAILED TO CHECK THE CONTENTS OF THE POCKETS, YOU BECAME RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY CONTRABAND FOUND WITHIN THEM. AS A RESULT, THE DHO DETERMINED YOU WERE CHARGED ACCORDINGLY.

BASED UPON THE STAFF'S EYEWITNESS ACCOUNT OF THE INCIDENT AND THE WRITTEN REPORT, THE DHO FINDS THAT YOU COMMITTED THE PROHIBITED ACT OF POSSESSION OF DRUGS, CODE 113, AND SANCTIONED YOU ACCORDINGLY.





PART B - RESPONSE

This is in response to your Regional Administrative Remedy Appeal receipted July 08, 2019. You appeal the decision of the Discipline Hearing Officer (DHO) on August 28, 2018, for Possession of Drugs, Code 113. As relief, you request the incident report be expunged.

Program Statement 5270.09, Inmate Discipline Program, provides the DHO shall consider all evidence presented during the hearing. The DHO's decision will be based on at least some facts and if there is conflicting evidence, on the greater weight of the evidence. The DHO considered your statement provided during the DHO proceedings. The DHO found you committed the prohibited act based on the greater weight of the evidence which was the reporting officer's statement and supporting documents.

You allege the substance found was not properly tested. After review of the paperwork it has been determined that the proper procedures were used to identify the substance. The DHO adequately explained to you the specific evidence relied on to find you committed the prohibited act. The sanctions imposed were available and appropriate for the offense level.

Accordingly, your Regional Administrative Remedy Appeal is denied. If dissatisfied with this response, you may appeal to the Office of General Counsel, Bureau of Prisons, 320 First Street, NW, Washington, DC 20534. Your appeal must be received in the Office of General Counsel within 30 calendar days of the date of this response.
