William R. Gallagher installed on Board of Directors of nation's top criminal defense organization

Washington D.C. — William R. Gallagher of Cincinnati, Ohio, was sworn in as a member of the Board of Directors of the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers at its annual meeting in San Francisco July 31.

Gallagher is a founding member of the Ohio Innocence Project at the University of Cincinnati Law School, where he is an adjunct faculty member. He currently serves as vice-chair of NACDL's Death Penalty Committee, Board Member of both the Ohio Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers and the Greater Cincinnati Criminal Defense Lawyers Association, member of Ohioans to Stop Executions and co-chair of the Indigent Defense Committee of OACDL. He is also a CJA panel representative for the Southern District of Ohio.

In 2005-2006, Gallagher will serve NACDL as Co-Chair of the CLE Committee.
