## **Stephen Glassroth installed as secretary of nation's top criminal defense organization**

Washington, D.C. – Stephen Glassroth was installed as secretary of the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers last week at their annual meeting in San Francisco.

Glassroth has served as a member of the board of directors for the past six years. He also served as president of the Alabama Criminal Defense Lawyers Association during the 1995-1996 term.

Glassroth won a unique federal court victory in July, defending his client's First and Sixth Amendment right to publish a "Wanted Poster"-style Web site seeking information on agents and cooperating witnesses in his ongoing marijuana distribution case. As a member of the Alabama Bar, he was also the plaintiff with injury-in-fact in the now-famous "Ten Commandments Case," *Glassroth v. Moore*.
