



## NACDL 2019 Election Nomination Petition

The deadline to submit a petition, along with a statement of qualifications, a photo, and a statement that the petitioner is a member in good standing with his or her respective bar is Thursday, June 13, by 5:00 pm Eastern Time. Petitioners must disclose if they are under indictment or information for any felony, or crime including moral turpitude. Candidates will be responsible for confirming that their materials have been received. All petition materials (including statement of qualifications, photo, statement of good standing, and any and all submitted petition signature forms) must be submitted in a single electronic transmittal.

Petitions must be emailed to Elections Registrar to Daniel Weir at [dweir@nacdl.org](mailto:dweir@nacdl.org) (and paper copies must also be received at NACDL's office, located at 1660 L Street NW, 12<sup>th</sup> Floor, Washington, DC 20036).

We, the undersigned members in good standing of the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers, each of whom is qualified to vote, do hereby nominate \_\_\_\_\_ for the office of \_\_\_\_\_ of the National Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers for the 2019 Annual Election.

Article VIII, §§ 1-2 of the NACDL Bylaws require a candidate running for office by petition to provide *at least 30 signatures* of NACDL voting members in good standing, at least 10 of whom are from the nominee's Federal Judicial Circuit. Please submit more than the minimum requirement of 30 signatures, in the event a few of the individuals who sign may no longer be members or otherwise not eligible voting NACDL members. Please note that only signatures of those members whose dues are current at the time of the signature are valid. The burden to provide 30 valid signatures lies with the petitioner; failure to meet this requirement will result in the petitioner being kept off the ballot. Finally, please note that illegible names may not be counted.

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
