THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

**COUNT ONE
Interstate Threatening Communication
[18 U.S.C. § 875(c)]**

On or about January 23, 2025, in the Western District of Texas and elsewhere,
Defendant,

JAMES WESLEY BURGER,

did knowingly transmit in interstate commerce a communication, specifically, statements on Roblox publicly accessible to attack a Christian concert, and the communication contained a threat to injure the person of another. Specifically, the communication included a threat to “deal a grievous wound upon the followers of the Cross.”

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 875(c).

COUNT TWO
Interstate Threatening Communication
[18 U.S.C. § 875(c)]

On or about January 27, 2025, in the Western District of Texas and elsewhere,
Defendant,

JAMES WESLEY BURGER,

did knowingly transmit in interstate commerce a communication, specifically, statements on Roblox publicly accessible to attack a Christian concert, and the communication contained a threat to injure the person of another. Specifically, the communication included:


“I’ve come to conclude it will befall the 12 of Shawwal aa/And it will be a music festival/Attracting bounties of Christians s/In’shaa’allah we willl attain martyrdom /And deal a greivous wound upon the followers of the Cross /Pray for me and enjoin yourself to martyrdom[.]”

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 875(c).
