INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges that:

COUNT 1

(Assault of a Federal Officer)

On or about June 6, 2025, in Island County, within the Western District of Washington, VICTOR VIVANCO-REYES knowingly, intentionally, and forcibly assaulted Victim 1, an officer of the United States and of an agency of the United States Government, that is, the United States Department of Homeland Security, Homeland Security Investigations, while Victim 1 was engaged in and on account of his performance of official duties.

1 The Grand Jury further alleges that the above acts of VICTOR VIVANCO-
2 REYES involved physical contact with Victim 1.

3 The Grand Jury further alleges that VICTOR VIVANCO-REYES used a deadly
4 and dangerous weapon, that is, a truck with attached trailer, during the commission of the
5 above acts.

6 All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 111(a) and (b).

7 **COUNT 2**

8 **(Assault of a Federal Officer)**

9 On or about June 6, 2025, in Island County, within the Western District of
10 Washington, VICTOR VIVANCO-REYES knowingly, intentionally, and forcibly
11 assaulted Victim 2, an officer of the United States and of an agency of the United States
12 Government, that is, the United States Department of Homeland Security, Homeland
13 Security Investigations, while Victim 2 was engaged in and on account of his
14 performance of official duties.

15 The Grand Jury further alleges that the above acts of VICTOR VIVANCO-
16 REYES involved physical contact with Victim 2.

17 The Grand Jury further alleges that the above acts of VICTOR VIVANCO-
18 REYES inflicted bodily injury to Victim 2.

19 The Grand Jury further alleges that VICTOR VIVANCO-REYES used a deadly
20 and dangerous weapon, that is, a truck with attached trailer, during the commission of the
21 above acts.

22 All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 111(a) and (b).

23 **COUNT 3**

24 **(Assault of a Federal Officer)**

25 On or about June 6, 2025, in Island County, within the Western District of
26 Washington, VICTOR VIVANCO-REYES knowingly, intentionally, and forcibly

1 assaulted Victim 3, an officer of the United States and of an agency of the United States
2 Government, that is, the United States Department of Homeland Security, Homeland
3 Security Investigations, while Victim 3 was engaged in and on account of his
4 performance of official duties.

5 The Grand Jury further alleges that the above acts of VICTOR VIVANCO-
6 REYES involved physical contact with Victim 3.

7 The Grand Jury further alleges that VICTOR VIVANCO-REYES used a deadly
8 and dangerous weapon, that is, a truck with attached trailer, during the commission of the
9 above acts.

10 All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 111(a) and (b).

11 **COUNT 4**

12 **(Assault of a Federal Officer)**

13 On or about June 6, 2025, in Island County, within the Western District of
14 Washington, VICTOR VIVANCO-REYES knowingly, intentionally, and forcibly
15 assaulted Victim 4, an officer of the United States and of an agency of the United States
16 Government, that is, the United States Customs and Border Protection, while Victim 4
17 was engaged in and on account of his performance of official duties.

18 The Grand Jury further alleges that the above acts of VICTOR VIVANCO-
19 REYES involved physical contact with Victim 4.

20 The Grand Jury further alleges that the above acts of VICTOR VIVANCO-
21 REYES inflicted bodily injury to Victim 4.
