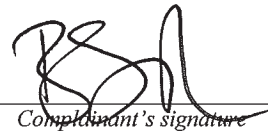
I, the undersigned complainant, being duly sworn, state the following is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.

Count 1: On or about January 12, 2026, in the State and District of Minnesota, the defendant **Alice Valentine** (YOB 2000) did forcibly assault, resist, oppose, impede, intimidate, and interfere with a person designated in 18 U.S.C. § 1114, namely, Victim 1, a Deportation Officer of the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement, who was engaged in, and on account of, the performance of official duties, and such acts involved physical contact with Victim 1, all in violation of Title 18, Section 111(a)(1).
