This project and continuing research has helped scientists and doctors determine which SNPs (variations) are harmful and which are not a concern to your health.

When a patient has SNP testing, clinicians can focus their attention on genetic variations that can lead to poor health and offer the patient guidance in the prevention of health problems or create a protocol to help those with current health problems.

How it works

Kit contents:

- 1x requisition form
- 1x instructions card
- 1x buccal swab
- 1x ID label sticker
- 1x containment bag
- 1x prepaid return shipping bag

Steps:

- 1. Collect the DNA sample (cheek swab) according to the included instructions.
- 2. Complete the requisition form and any additional instructions. These items must accompany the sample.
- 3. Submit the sample and forms to the laboratory via prepaid return shipping bag.
- 4. Results are provided via online provider portal typically in 5-10 business days after receipt of the sample.
