On or about July 24, 2025, in Los Angeles County, within the Central District of California, defendant ALEXANDRIA DEMETRIUS AUGUSTINE, intentionally and forcibly assaulted, resisted, impeded, intimidated, and interfered with victim A.G., an employee of the

1 Federal Protective Service, while A.G. was engaged in, and on account
2 of, the performance of A.G.'s official duties.

COUNT TWO

[40 U.S.C. § 1315(c); 41 C.F.R. § 102-74.390(c)]

[CLASS C MISDEMEANOR]

On or about July 24, 2025, on federal property under the authority of the General Services Administration, where signage regulating conduct was conspicuously posted, in Los Angeles County, within the Central District of California, defendant ALEXANDRIA DEMETRIUS AUGUSTINE caused a disturbance by knowingly and willfully engaging in conduct that impeded and disrupted the performance of official duties by government employees, namely, employees of the Federal Protective Service.

COUNT THREE

[40 U.S.C. § 1315(c); 41 C.F.R. § 102-74.385]

[CLASS C MISDEMEANOR]

On or about July 24, 2025, on federal property under the authority of the General Services Administration, where signage regulating conduct was conspicuously posted, in Los Angeles County, within the Central District of California, defendant ALEXANDRIA DEMETRIUS AUGUSTINE knowingly and willfully failed to comply with official signs of a prohibitory, regulatory or directory nature and with the lawful directions of Federal police officers and other authorized individuals, namely, employees of the Federal Protective Service.
